Pure form of tumor protein extracted successfully



The feat which was performed individually in 3 different labs proves how the protein keeps [tumors](#) in check.



It further gives an insight into how in the BRCA2 sequence causes [cancer](#) and paves way for research on compounds that could block this destructive process.

Some mutations in the gene coding for BRCA2 enhances the probability that a person will develop breast, ovarian and other [types](#) of cancer in the future, reveal researchers.

The studies

Stephen Kowalczykowski, a biochemist at the University of California, and his team purified the protein by adding a maltose-binding protein tag to one end of the [BRCA2](#) protein.

The tag helps enhance the solubility of the protein and promotes proper protein folding, hence stabilizing it.

Finally, the protein was extracted in its pure form from cultured human epithelial kidney cells.

"Ryan Jensen, a postdoc in Kowalczykowski's lab and the first author on the Nature paper¹, spent four years simply optimizing the purification process", Kowalczykowski says.

In the second lab, a different approach was used by researcher Wolf-Dietrich Heyer, a biochemist at the University of California, and his team. They expressed the protein in the yeast and extracted the protein successfully.

In the third study, led by Stephen West, a geneticist at Cancer Research UK in London, BRCA2 gene was inserted into cultured human epithelial [cancer cells](#) as part of a bacterial construct.

Eventually, tags were added to the proteins in order to help purify them easily.

With the protein in hand, scientists can now "do all types of mechanistic experiments" that have so far eluded researchers, says Patrick Sung, a biochemist at Yale University in New Haven, who was not involved in the study.

"The significance is enormous," he says, "not only in understanding how BRCA2 works, but also in providing a framework for working with other [proteins](#) known to interact with it."

The findings are published online in 'Nature¹' and 'Nature Structural & Molecular Biology'.

Barriers to the extraction

The major difficulty faced by the teams was the size of the protein which clocked in at 3,418 amino acids.

"That is really huge," says Heyer. "I'm not aware of any other proteins that size that have been purified to homogeneity."

Secondly, BRCA2 is extremely unstable on its own, and commonly exists in complexes with other proteins due

to which it gets difficult to extract it in its pure form.

"People have got it partially purified, but the question has always been contamination," Kowalczykowski says. "You really need to get it squeaky clean, and that has been the major stumbling block."


